

Portbury Dock Renewable Energy Plant Information sheet



Our proposal

We're hoping to develop a biomass-fired renewable energy plant, adjacent to the Royal Portbury Dock within the Port of Bristol. The site is around 9km north-west of Bristol city centre and approximately 2km to the west of the M5, between Junctions 18 and 19. A map of the site location is shown overleaf.

Rated at approximately 150MW, the site could produce enough renewable energy for around 200,000* homes, by burning fuel known as biomass. This could include recycled wood, sustainably grown wood and dedicated energy crops.

*Based on Digest of UK Energy Statistics, 2007 and an estimated availability of 90% running capacity.

Environmental consideration

As part of our Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), independent experts have carried out a number of comprehensive studies. These studies determined how the proposed renewable energy plant may affect the environment.

In summary, no significant impacts were identified through the EIA process. The results of the EIA will be documented in an

Environmental Statement (ES) and Non-Technical Summary (NTS) which will be made available on our website at eon-uk.com/portburydock

Community liaison and benefits

We're fully committed to working in partnership with the community by:

- planning a fund to support community projects of around £50,000 per year, totalling more than £1 million over the operational life of the plant. We would like to hear your suggestions on how this fund could be spent. Please note that the community fund is separate to the planning decision.
- creating around 300 short-term jobs during the construction phase, and 35 full-time jobs once the plant is in operation. We'll seek to recruit locally where possible.

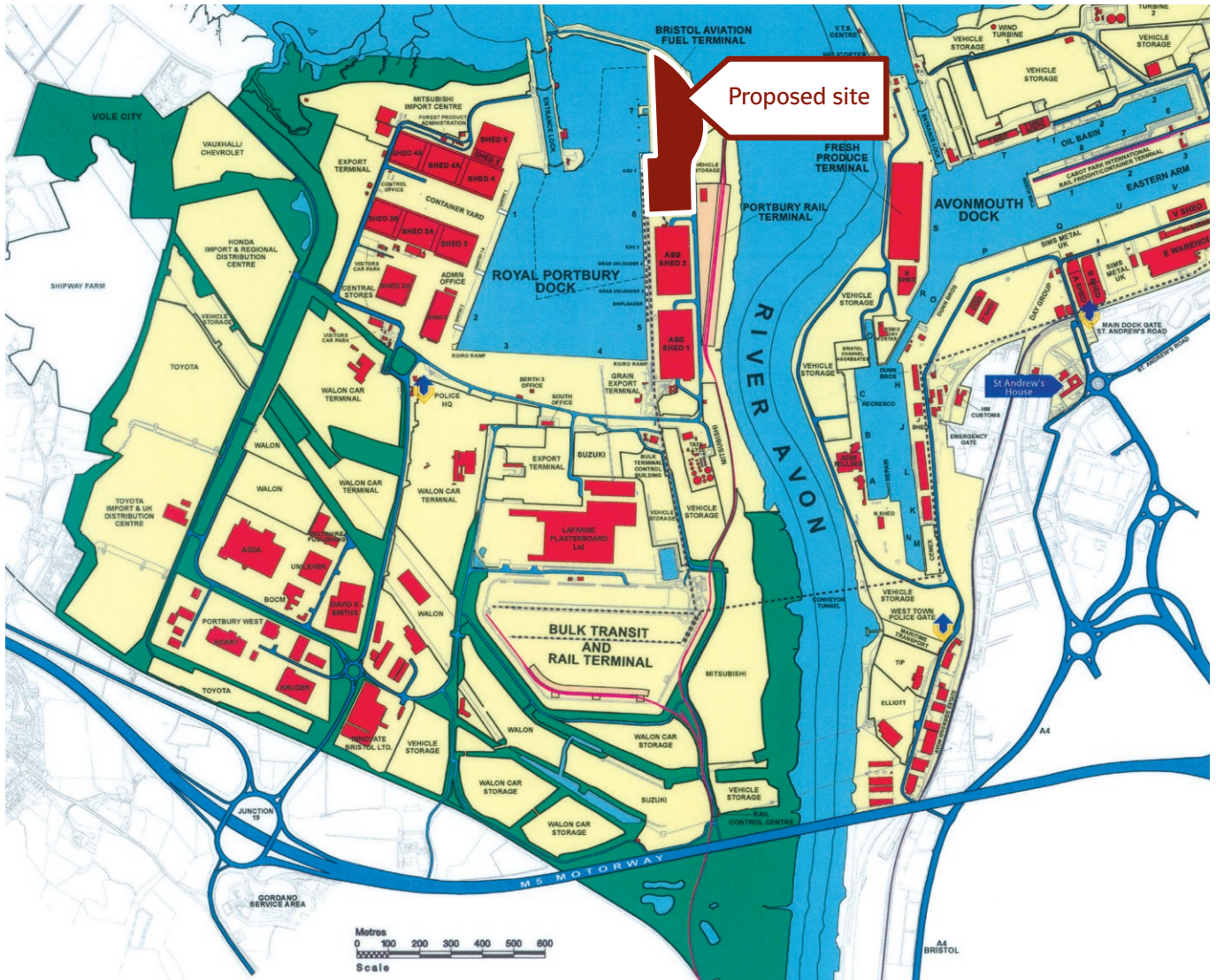
