

# Turbines on your land



Wind resource is the main consideration as to whether a site is suitable for a wind farm. Not every windy location, however, is suitable for one.

Here are a few simple criteria that could help you assess your land:

- The size of the land should be greater than 350 acres. The actual wind turbines would only use 1% of this area but a distance of about 400m would need to separate the turbines.
- A certain distance should be kept between the location of every wind turbine and the nearest dwellings. As a starting point we use a 750m buffer.
- The land should be sited outside national designated areas such as National Parks, Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty or Sites of Special Scientific Interest.



## Your next step

If your potential site meets these simple criteria then it could be suitable for a wind farm development.
